

GENERAL INFORMATION

Moulton Corner community is located northwest of the capital city of Monrovia and is situated in the township of Brewerville. It is one of the oldest and largest communities with many different tribes living here. The community has little provision shops, gas station, market and drug store. The people live off of making small gardens and burning core. Most of the wells in this community are open top without culverts. The people draw water from the well but it is not safe for drinking.

The LWI Liberia team rehabilitated the open top well by cleaning out the debris and sealing up the well with a pump base. The team also chlorinated the well and installed a new India Mark II hand pump. Moulton community is now enjoying clean, safe water. The hygiene team taught the community how to keep their pump and the well site clean. The team also demonstrated how someone can carry germs and how to prevent themselves from getting infected with bacteria.
